**Dosage:** 500 ml to 5 l water

For extremely dirty windscreens and for thorough cleaning of windscreens **RAVENOL Sommerscheibenreiniger 1: 10** can also be used only slightly diluted.

In every dilution ratio **RAVENOL Sommerscheibenreiniger 1: 10** is completely soluble in water.
